

Business Diploma level 3

Course Overview

This Business Diploma programme (equivalent to two A levels) incorporates a range of essential skills needed to progress into a career in the world of business or higher education. The diverse nature of this course gives you an insight into all sides of the industry, allowing you to focus on the aspects that interest you the most and help you on the path to employment with a suitable career choice.

What you will learn

You will learn about the intricacies of Business across a range of topics, including: 1. International business 2. Principles of management 3. Visual merchandising 4. Managing a business event The aim is to develop your general understanding of key business areas, leaving the opportunity for further study in higher education as well as building towards senior roles in established businesses or starting your own enterprise.

Entry Requirements

You must have achieved a minimum of 3 merits and completed the 360 hours Extended Certificate course. You also need a strong reference, a minimum of 95% attendance and complete the interview process.

How you will be assessed

Assessments take place through a combination of portfolios, presentations and BTEC exams. You will also be expected to take part in work experience placement or industrial placement, as these are crucial to your employability skills and development. In addition, as part of the study programme, you will take part in workshop sessions, tutorials and other employability skills.

Course Fees

Course fees £40.00 and additional trip fees will be incurred of £30.00 Please see Student Services if you think you may be eligible for financial support.

Course Progression

Upon completion you can either progress onto a Higher National Diploma in Business and related subjects at Leicester College or a degree programme at an alternative provider. In addition, this course will give you an excellent insight into business-related topics that can be transferred to the world of work, either in full or part-time employment or on a higher apprenticeship programme.
