Course Overview

What you will learn

This course will show you the basic tools in Adobe Photoshop. You'll learn how to use palettes and windows, view menus, and make custom palettes. You'll explore image resolution for print and screen, color modes, and basic adjustments like tone, shadows, highlights, and color. You will also practice simple changes, such as scaling, rotating, flipping, and changing perspective.

by You will also learn basic photo retouching skills, including patching, healing, cloning, sharpening, doging, burning, masking, and making montages. You will learn both the ideas and the practical use of these tools to fix common digital image problems.

br /> sbr /> the course also covers Adobe Lightroom. You'll learn key photo editing skills like organising images, adjusting colors and exposure, and using presets. This course is perfect for beginners who want to improve their photography skills.
