Introduction to Small Gift Craft Making 1

Course Overview

This non-accredited course runs from City Skills Centre, each Monday, 12:15pm - 2:45pm for 9 weeks, starting on 8 September and finishing on 10 November 2025.
 /> This is an introductory course. You do not need to have any previous experience. This is an opportunity for you to try various craft techniques. All materials will be provided.

What you will learn

During this course, you will learn: $\langle br / \rangle \langle br / \rangle$ - How to create personalised items using unique designs $\langle br / \rangle$ - How to use various pens and brushes to create designs $\langle br / \rangle$ - How to complete Art projects, including coasters and gift tags $\langle br / \rangle$ - How to draw, paint, design patterns and drawings $\langle br / \rangle$ - How to upcycle small items for gifts and home decor $\langle br / \rangle \langle br / \rangle$ This is a tutor led course. However, students can choose their own project in week 8 and 9.

Entry Requirements

This course is designed as an introductory course and no previous skills or experience are required.
 You must be aged 19+ and be able to complete a short workbook on a weekly basis with the help of your tutor.

How you will be assessed

There are no formal assessments, exams or coursework. Your tutor will informally assess your progress each week.

 You will receive a certificate of course completion based on your progress in class and attendance.
