What you will learn

The course covers drawing and painting, 3D design, ceramics, textiles, mixed media, pattern and print, graphics, photography, producing craft items and art history.

You will learn how to work safely within the workshops and gain the technical skills to be able to operate appropriate machinery safely. Maths and English will also be studied at an appropriate level.

Entry Requirements

You will require two qualifications GCSE or equivalent at grade 2 including: $\langle br/\rangle x1$ GCSE in a design related subject $\langle br/\rangle x1$ GCSE other subject $\langle br/\rangle \langle br/\rangle x1$ GCSE English needs minimum grade 1 or equivalent. $\langle br/\rangle \langle br/\rangle x1$ A Portfolio of Artwork is required to review ability and provide guidance at interview. Consideration will be given to all applicants over the age of 19 who do not hold formal English and maths qualifications. $\langle br/\rangle \langle br/\rangle x1$ Aptitude for full time study is essential.

Course Fees

There is a potential trip fee of £20. This will be confirmed in year.

Course Progession

Successful completion of the level 1 Diploma in Art and Design can lead to progression to the BTEC level 2 Diploma in Art and Design, Media, Fashion or Graphic Design and Photography. It can also lead to junior-level work in an art/design or media related area or appropriate related apprenticeships.
