

Preparation for College Launchpad

Course Overview

This course is designed for those not attending school or engaging with education. If you're unsure what your next step will be, this is a great short course to see what College is all about. It runs for seven weeks, one day per week, and each week you will experience a taster session in a new area of the College.

What you will learn

You will take part in taster sessions in the following areas: catering, engineering, digital music, enterprise, motor vehicle, construction, and theatrical make-up. These might not be areas you considered before, but you never know, you might unlock a hidden talent. This is all practical too, no tests or exams, it is all about the experience.

Entry Requirements

If you aren't currently in education, then this is the course for you. You need to be in year 12. We cannot take anyone under the age of 15.

Course Progression

Hopefully, the tasters will inspire you to apply for College this September. The final day includes a session from an independent careers advisor who can help you research courses and get that application in. They can also advise you on CV writing, job applications and apprenticeships. We have strong links with the NHS, the biggest employer in the City, and there could be just the opportunity for you there.

What Happens Next

Apply online via the College website. You will need details of your qualifications and employment history, a reference, and a personal statement to complete your application. Once your application has been successfully processed, you will be sent a conditional offer and be invited to a Welcome Event at the College to meet your tutors, learn more about your chosen course of study and tour the facilities. You will then need to confirm your acceptance of the course offered to you.
