

## Beginners' Ceramics - Hand-building with clay

### Course Overview

This is a fun and practical course held at St. Margaret's Campus, where you'll learn how to make things out of clay by hand. It's great for beginners and no experience is needed. You'll try out different ways of working with clay, like pinching, coiling, and using slabs to build shapes. You'll also learn how to decorate your work, add glaze, and find out how pottery is fired in a kiln. All materials are included, and you get to take home the pieces you make.

### What you will learn

You will learn key hand-building techniques with clay. This includes pinching, coiling, and slab construction. You'll explore how to shape and join clay to make simple ceramic forms. The course also covers surface decoration, texturing, and the basics of glazing. You'll understand how to prepare your work for firing. You'll gain insight into the ceramic process from start to finish. You will learn to use tools and materials safely in a studio. By the end of the course, you'll have created your own ceramic pieces using the skills you've developed.
